On October 24, 2018, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) filed an executed Transferred Frequency Response Agreement (Agreement) with Bonneville Power Administration.¹ The Agreement specifies the terms and conditions under which Bonneville Power Administration will provide transferred frequency response to CAISO. Waiver of the Commission's notice requirements pursuant to section 35.11 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 35.11) is granted,² and the Agreement is accepted for filing, effective December 1, 2018, as requested.

This filing was noticed on October 24, 2018, with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before November 14, 2018. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
