On October 21, 2020, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted revisions to its transmission tariff (Tariff) in response to the Commission's directives in its September 2020 Order<sup>1</sup> addressing CAISO's Order No. 831<sup>2</sup> compliance filing. CAISO's revisions are in satisfactory compliance with the September 2020 Order, and are accepted for filing, effective March 21, 2021.<sup>3</sup>
