On October 24, 2013, AES Huntington Beach, L.L.C. (AESHB) submitted for filing a revised Rate Schedule No. 2, Reliability Must-Run (RMR) Agreement for Huntington Beach Generating Station Units 3 and 4 with the California Independent System Operator Corporation. The revision implements an extension of the contract term for 2014, as provided by the terms of the RMR Agreement. The revised RMR Agreement is accepted, effective January 1, 2014.

This filing was noticed on October 25, 2013, with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before November 14, 2013. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214).
