On October 23, 2012, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted for filing revisions to its open access transmission tariff to clarify its role as the central counterparty. Waiver of the Commission's notice requirements pursuant to section 35.11 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 35.11) is granted, and the tariff record is accepted, effective November 1, 2012.
