Re: California Independent System Operator Corporation Filing to Comply with Order No. 676-G
Docket No. ER14- -000

Dear Secretary Bose:

The California Independent System Operator Corporation ("ISO")¹ submits this filing in compliance with the Commission's Order No. 676-G.² In Order No. 676-G, the Commission directed public utilities to incorporate by reference in their jurisdictional tariffs certain business practice standards promulgated by the Wholesale Electric Quadrant ("WEQ") of the North American Energy Standards Board ("NAESB") and included by reference in the Commission's regulations. None of the NAESB standards adopted by Order No. 676-G require substantive ISO tariff revisions for implementation. The ISO accordingly requests Commission acceptance of proposed modifications to the ISO tariff to incorporate the NAESB standards into the tariff by reference, effective 61 days after the date of this filing, *i.e.*, February 18, 2014.

I. Background

Order No. 676-G directed Independent System Operators ("ISOs") and Regional Transmission Organizations ("RTOs") to revise their Open Access Transmission Tariffs ("OATTs") to include the following NAESB business practice standards: (1) the NAESB Phase II Demand Response Measurement and

Standards for Business Practices and Communication Protocols for Public Utilities, Order No. 676-G, FERC Stats. & Regs. ¶ 31,343 (2013) ("Order No. 676-G"). The ISO submits this filing pursuant to section 205 of the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. § 824d.

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Verification ("M&V") Standards collectively identified by NAESB as 2010 WEQ Annual Plan Items 4(a) and 4(b); and (2) the NAESB Energy Efficiency M&V Standards collectively identified by NAESB as 2010 WEQ Annual Plan Item 4(d).³ The Commission also incorporated those NAESB standards into its regulations by reference.⁴

The Commission stated that if adoption of the NAESB standards did not require any changes or revisions to an ISO's or RTO's existing OATT provisions, such ISOs and RTOs could comply with Order No. 676-G by adding provisions to their OATTs that incorporated the NAESB standards by reference. The Commission directed that such ISOs and RTOs incorporate these NAESB standards by adding the following referencing language to their OATTs:

Measurement and Verification of Wholesale Electricity Demand Response (WEQ-015, 2010 Annual Plan Items 4(a) and 4(b), March 21, 2011), and Measurement and Verification of Wholesale Electricity Efficiency (WEQ-021 2010 Annual Plan Item 4(d), July 16, 2012).⁶

The Commission explained that compliance with Order No. 676-G would be required as of the date the Order became effective, *i.e.*, May 6, 2013. However, any OATT revisions required to comply with Order No. 676-G needed to be filed by December 31, 2013.

II. Proposed Tariff Revisions

In accordance with Order No. 676-G, the ISO has modified section 7.3.3 of its tariff to incorporate those NAESB standards by reference, using the referencing language prescribed in Order 676-G quoted above.

III. Effective Date
