## ORDER GRANTING REHEARING FOR FURTHER CONSIDERATION

(February 21, 2003)

Rehearing has been timely requested of the Commission order issued on December 23, 2002, in Docket Nos. EL03-14-000, et al., City of Azusa, California, et al., 101 ¶ 61,352 (2002) and in Docket Nos. EL00-105-006, et al. City of Vernon, California, et al., 101 FERC ¶ 61,353 (2002). In the absence of Commission action within 30 days, those requests for rehearing (and any timely requests for rehearing filed subsequently)¹ would be deemed denied. 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
