NOTICE OF EFFECTIVE DATE BY THE CALIFORNIA INDEPENDENT SYSTEM OPERATOR CORPORATION

On September 5, 2014, the Commission issued an order that accepted tariff amendments filed by the California Independent System Operator Corporation ("CAISO") to enhance the outage management process, change the timeline for scheduling coordinators to submit planned and forced outages, and expand the outage options available to scheduling coordinators for resource adequacy resources. The Commission approved the tariff amendments to become effective on September 22, 2014.¹

Following issuance of the September 5 Order, the CAISO filed three petitions for temporary suspension of the effectiveness, or limited waiver, of the tariff revisions accepted in this proceeding, which were granted by Commission.² The most recent

On September 11, 2014, the CAISO filed a request to modify the effective date of the tariff revisions from September 22 to December 1, 2014 to accommodate the requests of market participants for additional time for system changes and training prior to implementation of the new outage management system. The Commission granted the CAISO's request by order dated October 2, 2014.

On November 17, 2014, the CAISO filed a request to modify the effective date of the tariff revisions to a date later in December to address market participants' readiness concerns. On December 1, 2014 the Commission issued an Order granting the request and permitting the tariff revisions to be implemented on either the date the CAISO notifies the Commission that the outage management system is operational, or December 31, 2014, whichever occurs first. On December 5, 2015, the CAISO filed a request to modify the effective date of the tariff revisions until February 28, 2015 to allow the CAISO additional time to address transitional issues and maintain stabilized system operations before the next major system change. The Commission granted that request by order dated December 31, 2014.

order granted the CAISO's motion to permit the tariff modifications to be effective either

on the date that the CAISO informs the Commission that the new outage management

system is operational, or February 28, 2015, whichever comes first. The order directed

the CAISO to notify the Commission within two days of the actual effective date.

In accordance with that directive, the CAISO submits this notice to advise the

Commission that the outage management system will be operational on February 27,

2015, and that the tariff revisions will be implemented as of that date.
