ORDER OF CHIEF JUDGE CONTINUING TO HOLD PROCEEDING IN ABEYANCE AND ORDERING FURTHER STATUS REPORTS

(Issued June 10, 2016)

- 1. On May 16, 2016, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (ISO) filed a status report which stated that ". . . there have been no occurrences that alter the conclusion reached by the ISO and active parties to this proceeding . . . that the procedural schedule in these proceedings should continue to be suspended pending the outcome of the California refund proceeding."¹
- 2. On June 9, 2016, the Chief Administrative Law Judge (Chief Judge) convened a status conference at which the proceeding participants provided an update on the posture of the proceeding and its nexus to the ISO's May 4, 2016 compliance filing in Docket No. EL00-95, currently pending before the Commission on review. Based on the representations made at the status conference, it is ordered that the proceeding continue to be held in abeyance for a period of six months, at which time another status conference will be scheduled to assess the appropriate action to be taken. The ISO is also ordered to

continue to file a status report with the Chief Judge every 90 days, and for these status reports to provide greater detail and elaboration than the most recent filings.
