On May 14, 2021, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) filed a certificate of concurrence corresponding to an Affected Participating Transmission Owner Upgrade Facilities Agreement among Southern California Edison Company (SoCal Edison), Yellow Pine Solar, LLC, and CAISO.¹ CAISO explains that the Upgrade Facilities Agreement, filed with the Commission by SoCal Edison, was accepted by the Commission effective April 30, 2021.² CAISO requests that the certificate of concurrence be accepted effective April 30, 2021.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, your submittal is accepted for filing, effective April 30, 2021, as requested.<sup>3</sup>

The filing was noticed on May 19, 2021, with comments, interventions, and protests due on or before June 4, 2021. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214), to the extent that any timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time were filed before the issuance date of this order, such interventions are granted. Granting late interventions at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your filing; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against CAISO.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
