### Re: California Independent System Operator Corporation – Filing of Certificate of Concurrence Relating to the non-conforming Large Generator Interconnection Agreement Submitted in Docket No. ER20-1938

Dear Secretary Bose:

The California Independent System Operator Corporation ("CAISO") hereby submits for filing a Certificate of Concurrence with respect to the non-conforming Large Generator Interconnection Agreement ("LGIA") among Luz Solar Partners LTD., VIII ("Interconnection Customer"), Southern California Edison Company ("SCE"), and the CAISO ("Kramer Junction 8 LGIA").<sup>1</sup>

## I. Overview and Designated Filer

On May 29, 2020, SCE submitted the Kramer Junction 8 LGIA in Docket No. ER20-1938, with a requested effective date of May 30, 2020. In that filing, SCE explained that the non-conforming Kramer Junction 8 LGIA deviates from the CAISO *pro forma* LGIA to account for the situation where an interconnection customer desires to convert its interconnection from California Public Utilities Commission–jurisdictional service to Commission–jurisdictional service.

Rather than filing a duplicate version of the Kramer Junction 8 LGIA under the CAISO tariff, the CAISO is submitting a concurrence tariff record. The concurrence tariff record is designated under the CAISO tariff as Service Agreement No. 6166.

SCE serves as the "designated filer" as to the Kramer Junction 8 LGIA pursuant to the Joint Tariff Filing procedures outlined in Order No. 714.<sup>2</sup> As the Participating Transmission Owner and a party to the LGIA, SCE filed the service agreement under SCE's FERC Electric Tariff, Original Volume No. 6 and designated it as Service Agreement No. 247.

## II. Proposed Effective Date and General Request for Waivers

The CAISO respectfully requests any waivers of the Commission's filing regulations necessary to establish an effective date of May 30, 2020 for its Certificate of Concurrence for the Kramer Junction 8 LGIA, consistent with the May 30, 2020 effective date that SCE requested in its May 29, 2020 filing. To the extent that the enclosed materials and information do not meet the detailed filing requirements of the Commission's regulations, the CAISO respectfully requests that the Commission grant any necessary waivers.
