On May 22, 2009, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted a proposed tariff sheet to provide for the unwinding of firm transmission rights (FTRs) released for April 1, 2009 through March 31, 2010, which are no longer applicable due to the implementation of the CAISO's Market Redesign & Technology Upgrade (MRTU) Tariff on March 31, 2009. Waiver of the Commission's notice requirement pursuant to section 35.11 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 35.11) is granted. The tariff sheet is accepted for filing effective June 23, 2009, as requested.¹

The filing was noticed on May 26, 2009, with comments due on June 12, 2009. No protests or adverse comments were received. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.
