On September 16, 2002, as amended on October 3, 2002, Edison Source tendered for filing a notice of termination of its PX Participation Agreement with the California Independent System Operator Corporation, dated March 17, 1998, as amended, and withdrawal of Edison Source's Standing Request Relating to Inter-Scheduling Coordinator Trades, dated June 5, 1998. Edison Source states that it is no longer engaged in the energy trading business. Waiver of the notice requirements pursuant to section 35.11 of the Commission's rule and procedures is granted, and the notice of cancellation and withdrawal are accepted effective October 16, 2002, as requested.

This filing was noticed on October 30, 2002, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before November 12, 2002. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provision of Rule 214.

This acceptance shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now or pending or hereafter instituted by or against Edison Source.

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This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Tariffs and Market Development - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
