# STATUS REPORT ON SETTLEMENT NEGOTIATIONS AND REQUEST FOR CONTINUED DEFERMENT OF THE APPOINTMENT OF A SETTLEMENT JUDGE

TO: The Honorable Curtis L. Wagner, Jr. Chief Administrative Law Judge

Pursuant to the Order of Chief Judge Deferring Appointment of Settlement Judge, issued on February 10, 2006 in the above-captioned proceeding, the California Independent System Operator ("CAISO"), acting for itself and on behalf of Duke Energy South Bay, LLC ("DESB"), San Diego Gas & Electric Company, and the California Electricity Oversight Board (collectively, the "Parties") hereby submit this status report setting forth the progress made thus far in negotiating the outstanding issues in this proceeding.

On February 10, 2006, the Chief Judge granted the Parties' request for deferral of the appointment of a settlement judge for thirty (30) days to allow time for the Parties to conduct informal settlement discussions. Over the past thirty days, the Parties have conferred regarding the outstanding issues in this proceeding and, currently are considering a settlement proposal. The Parties believe that additional time to continue informal settlement discussions would be useful.

Accordingly, the Parties hereby request that the Chief Administrative Law Judge defer appointment of a settlement judge in this proceeding for another thirty (30) days to allow the Parties to continue the negotiation process independently.
