Dear Mr. Kunselman:

On January 18, 2011, you submitted for filing, on behalf of the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO), certain revisions to the generator interconnection procedures (GIP) under CAISO's tariff in compliance with the Commission's directives.¹ Additionally, you state the filing modifies the interconnection study deposit provisions contained in section 3.5.1(i) of Appendix Y to CAISO's tariff to accurately reflect the provisions agreed to in the stakeholder process and to correct an inadvertent error. CAISO's proposed tariff revisions are accepted for filing, effective December 19, 2010; the date specified in the December 16 Order.

This filing was noticed on January 19, 2011, with comments, protests or motions to intervene due on or before February 8, 2011. No protests or comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's

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Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rates or services provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against CAISO.

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
