## ORDER OF CHIEF JUDGE DEFERRING APPOINTMENT OF SETTLEMENT JUDGE

(Issued February 3, 2010)

- 1. The Commission, by order issued on January 29, 2010, 130 FERC ¶ 61,076, directed the Chief Judge to appoint a Settlement Judge to assist the parties in arriving at a settlement of the issues in this case. The Commission gave the parties the opportunity to request the Chief Judge to appoint a specific judge mutually agreed by all parties.
- 2. On February 2, 2010 the parties advised that they are engaged in multi-party settlement discussions and that additional settlement meetings are scheduled in the near future. The parties requested that the appointment of a settlement judge be deferred until March 1, 2010 pending the current informal settlement discussions.
- 3. Accordingly, for good cause shown, the Chief Judge hereby defers the appointment of a settlement judge until March 1, 2010. The parties shall provide the Chief Judge with a report on the status of the settlement negotiations on or before March 1, 2010.
