On March 25, 2008, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted an informational filing that provides notice of the revised Transmission Access Charges effective January 1, 2008. The CAISO states that the basis for the revision is to implement the revised Transmission Revenue Requirement associated with the revised Transmission Revenue Balancing Accounts of the Participating Transmission Owners (Participating TOs).¹ Receipt of the CAISO's instant informational filing is acknowledged.

The filing was noticed on March 26, 2008, with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before April 15, 2008. No adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.
