## ORDER OF CHIEF JUDGE STAYING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND WAIVING PERIOD FOR ANSWERS

(Issued May 30, 2014)

1. On May 29, 2014, counsel for Southern California Edison Company (SoCal Edison) and CalWind Resources, Inc. (CalWind), and the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) (collectively, Joint Movants) filed a *Joint Motion for Stay of Procedural Schedule* (Joint Motion). As grounds therefor, Joint Movants aver that the participants have reached a settlement in principle and that they need time to finalize and file the settlement agreement and related settlement documents. Joint Movants request that they be provided 90 days to complete the settlement process. Joints Movants represent that counsel for the Commission Trial Staff does not object to the request. Presiding Judge Steven L. Sterner does not object to the requested stay.

2. In light of the fact that the Joint Motion is unopposed, the period for answers is hereby waived. For good cause shown, and in the absence of objection, the procedural schedule in this proceeding is hereby stayed pending the finalization of the settlement documents and filing the settlement agreement with the Commission. Unless the settlement agreement is filed on or before August 29, 2014, Joint Movants will file a status report on that date.
