Dear Mr. Spomer:

On March 16, 2017, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted for filing a Planning Coordinator Agreement (PCA) between CAISO and Southern California Edison Company (SoCal Edison). The PCA sets forth the terms under which CAISO will serve as the planning coordinator for SoCal Edison's transmission facilities that are part of the bulk electric system located within CAISO's balancing authority area but are not under CAISO operational control. SoCal Edison will pay CAISO an annual service fee for its services as Planning Coordinator during the initial three-year term of the agreement. CAISO's PCA is accepted for filing, effective May 16, 2017, as requested.<sup>1</sup>

The filing was noticed on March 17, 2017, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before April 6, 2017. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.
