Dear Mr. Anders:

On March 15, 2018, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO), filed a revised Adjacent Balancing Authority Operating Agreement (Agreement) with Arizona Public Service Company (APS). The revisions reflect the addition of a new point of interconnection between the CAISO and APS balancing authority areas at the Delaney 500 kV Switchyard. The amended Agreement is accepted for filing, effective May 15, 2018, as requested.

This filing was noticed on March 15, 2018, with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before April 5, 2018. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.
