MOTION TO INTERVENE OF THE CALIFORNIA INDEPENDENT SYSTEM OPEPERATOR CORPORATION

Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 CFR 385.214) of the Federal Energy Regulatory

Commission's ("the Commission") Rules of Practice and Procedure, and the

Commission's June 25, 2003 "Order to Show Cause Concerning Gaming and/or

Anomalous Market Behavior Through the Use of Partnerships, Alliances, or Other Arrangements and Directing Submission of Information," 103 FERC ¶ 61,346 (2003) ("Partnership Order"), the California Independent System Operator Corporation ("ISO"), by and through its undersigned counsel, hereby moves to intervene in this proceeding. In support therefor, the ISO states as follows:

II. BACKGROUND

In the Partnership Order, the Commission found there to be evidence that Enron Power Marketing and the other entities named in these consolidated dockets "worked in concert through partnerships, alliances or other arrangements to engage in activities that constitute gaming and/or anomalous market behavior" in violation of the ISO and California Power Exchange ("PX") Tariffs during the period January 1, 2001 through June 20, 2001. Therefore, the Commission ordered these entities to show cause, in an evidentiary hearing before an administrative law judge ("ALJ") why this alleged behavior did not violate the ISO and PX Tariffs. The Commission also directed the ALJ to "hear evidence and render findings and conclusions quantifying the full extent to which the Partnership Entities may have been unjustly enriched as a result of their conduct." Partnership Order at P 2. The Commission stated that the ALJ could recommend the monetary remedy of disgorgement of unjust profits as well as any other additional, appropriate non-monetary remedies.

III. BASIS FOR MOTION TO INTERVENE

The ISO is a non-profit public benefit corporation organized under the laws of the State of California and responsible for the reliable operation of a grid comprising the transmission systems of Pacific Gas and Electric Company, San Diego Gas & Electric Company, the City of Vernon, California, and Southern California Edison, as well as for the coordination and monitoring of the competitive electricity market in California.

As the grid operator and market monitor, the ISO has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding that cannot be adequately represented by other parties. Moreover, it is the ISO's Tariff that the Commission has found may have been violated by the activities and behavior described in the Partnership Order, and much of the data and analysis concerning the transactions at issue was provided by the ISO. Therefore, the participation of the ISO is in the public interest and should be granted.

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IV. CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, the ISO respectfully requests that the

Commission permit it to intervene, and that it be accorded full party status in this

proceeding.
