II. BACKGROUND

On December 28, 2001, as described in the Notice of Filing, San Diego

Gas & Electric Company ("SDG&E") tendered for filing a change in rates for the

Transmission Revenue Balancing Account Adjustment and the Transmission Access Charge Balancing Account Adjustment set forth in its Transmission Owner Tariff; the effect of this rate change is to increase rates for jurisdictional transmission service utilizing that portion of the ISO-controlled grid owned by SDG&E. SDG&E requested that this rate change be made effective January 1, 2002.

III. BASIS FOR MOTION TO INTERVENE

The ISO is a non-profit public benefit corporation organized under the laws of the State of California and responsible for the reliable operation of a grid comprising the transmission systems of Pacific Gas and Electric Company, San Diego Gas & Electric Company, and Southern California Edison Company, as well as for the coordination of the competitive electricity market in California. As the operator of this grid, the ISO believes that it has a unique interest in any Commission proceeding concerning the SDG&E proposals described above.

IV. CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, the ISO respectfully requests that the

Commission permit it to intervene, and that it be accorded full party status in this

proceeding.
