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II. BACKGROUND

On August 19, 2004, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) tendered for filing an amendment to the Interconnection Agreement (IA) between PG&E and the Port of Oakland (Port) to include the Davis Substation at Transmission Voltage a Point of Interconnection. PG&E states that the IA is submitted pursuant to the PG&E Wholesale Distribution Tariff (WDT). PG&E requests an effective date of January 5, 2005.

By its Notice issued August 23, 2004, the Commission established September 9, 2004, as the date motions to intervene are to be filed in the above-captioned proceeding.
