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II. BACKGROUND

On February 19, 2004, Southern California Edison Company ("SCE") filed revised rate sheets to Rate Schedule FERC Nos. 112, 113, 421, and 342. The revisions to these rate sheets are made pursuant to a letter agreement (Letter Agreement) and various contract amendments between SCE and the State of California Department of Water Resources (CDWR "Parties, collectively") which provide for a reduction to CDWR's loss obligation to SCE, and resolve a longstanding billing dispute between the Parties.

By its Notice issued February 23, 2004, the Commission established March 11, 2004 as the date motions to intervene are to be filed in the above-captioned proceeding.

III. BASIS FOR MOTION TO INTERVENE

The ISO is a non-profit public benefit corporation organized under the laws of the State of California and responsible for the reliable operation of a grid comprising the transmission systems of Pacific Gas & Electric Company, Southern California Edison Company, San Diego Gas & Electric Company and the Cities of Vernon, Anaheim, Azusa, Banning and Riverside, California. As the operator of this grid, the ISO believes that it has a unique interest in any Commission proceeding concerning the issues raised in the captioned proceeding.

IV. CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, the ISO respectfully requests that the Commission permit it to intervene, and that the ISO be accorded full party status in this proceeding.
