II. BACKGROUND

On February 11, 2005, the City of Pasadena ("Pasadena") tendered for filing certain emissions cost calculations in the form of a compliance filing the results of which are to be included in the financial reruns of the ISO's settlements and billing system that have been ordered by the Commission in this proceeding. Pasadena's filing was required by the Commission's order of November 23, 2004 "Order on Rehearing", 109 FERC ¶ 61,218. Pasadena requested that the ISO apply \$593,536 as an emissions offset to any refunds that Pasadena is calculated to owe in the financial adjustment phase of the refund proceeding that will soon be conducted.

By its Notice issued February 18, 2005, the Commission established March 4, 2005, as the date that motions to intervene are to be filed in the above-captioned proceeding.

III. BASIS FOR MOTION TO INTERVENE

The ISO is a non-profit public benefit corporation organized under the laws of the state of California and responsible for the operation of a grid comprising
