MOTION FOR EXPEDITED SUSPENSION OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

To: The Honorable Joseph R. Nacy Presiding Administrative Law Judge

Pursuant to Rule 212 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 18

C.F.R. § 385.212, the California Independent System Operator Corporation ("ISO")

respectfully submits this motion for expedited suspension of the procedural schedule

established in the above-captioned proceeding on December 10, 2002.

The ISO and other parties in the proceeding have engaged in a series of

technical conferences and workshops to resolve all of the issues that are the subject of

the proceeding. The ISO and other parties are making progress toward a settlement and another technical conference call is scheduled for February 25, 2003. A temporary suspension is needed so that the parties can focus on reaching a complete settlement and prepare an offer of settlement.

Therefore, the ISO believes that good cause exists to temporarily suspend the current procedural schedule. If an offer of settlement is not agreed upon soon, the procedural schedule should be reinstated. Among the active parties to the proceeding, the California Department of Water Resources Energy Resources Scheduling, Pacific Gas and Electric Company, Southern California Edison Company, Powerex, Duke Energy Trading & Marketing, LLC, Dynegy Inc., Reliant Energy, Inc., and Williams Energy Marketing & Trading Company have informed the ISO that they do not oppose this motion. To that end, the ISO hereby respectfully requests that the procedural schedule be suspended prior to February 20, 2002, which is the first date for testimony and exhibits to be provided as described in the procedural schedule.
