Dear Secretary Boergers:

Please find enclosed a notice concerning the termination of the Participating Generator Agreement ("PGA") between the California Independent System Operator Corporation ("ISO") and Burney Forest Power ("Burney"). The PGA was filed with the Commission on June 4, 1998, in Docket No. ER98-3223-000, and accepted for filing by letter order dated July 6, 1998. Pursuant to the Commission's acceptance of the settlement in Docket Nos. ER98-992-000, et al., by letter order dated February 24, 2000, the ISO submitted an amended PGA on June 23, 2000. The Commission accepted this amended PGA for filing in a letter order dated August 9, 2000.

Section 3.2.2 of the PGA provides that Burney may terminate the agreement upon giving the ISO ninety days written notice, and that the agreement shall terminate upon acceptance by the Commission of the notice of termination. The ISO respectfully requests that the PGA be terminated effective as of the date on which Burney sent the
