On September 14, 2018, , the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) filed separate amendments to its Market Efficiency Enhancement Agreement (MEEA) with the Sacramento Municipal Utility District (SMUD), reflecting the incorporation of Sutter Energy Center as a supply resource into the CAISO's Full Network Model. Specifically, the first amendment incorporates the Sutter Energy Center into the MEEA supply resource portfolio and temporarily models its injections and withdrawals at the Hurley Substation; and, the second amendment reflects the long-term configuration of the Sutter Energy Center by modeling its injection and withdrawals at the Sutter substation. Waiver of the Commission's notice requirements pursuant to section 35.11 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 35.11) is granted,¹ and the amendments to the MEEA are accepted, effective September 15, 2018, and November 28, 2018, as requested.²

This filings were noticed on September 14, 2018, with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before October 5, 2018. No protests or adverse comments

were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against CAISO.

This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
