On October 10, 2017, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted a revision to section 24.13 of its tariff to remove an erroneous reference to section 24.4.4 of its tariff in compliance with the Commission's September 21 Order. CAISO's tariff revision complies with the September 21 Order, and is accepted for filing, effective September 27, 2017, as requested.

The filing was noticed on October 11, 2017, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before October 31, 2017. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action

is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against CAISO.

Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
