SUPPLEMENTAL COMMENTS OF THE CALIFORNIA INDEPENDENT SYSTEM OPERATOR CORPORATION

The California Independent System Operator Corporation ("CAISO") submits these supplemental comments in response to esVolta, LP's petition for limited waiver of the CAISO tariff.¹ Since the CAISO's previous comments, the period for validating interconnection requests and curing any deficiencies has lapsed,² and the CAISO and its participating transmission owners have commenced cluster 14 interconnection studies. As such, the CAISO cannot accommodate esVolta's interconnection request without restarting cluster 14 studies at the expense and delay of other interconnection customers. The CAISO respectfully requests that the Commission dismiss esVolta's petition as moot, consistent with the Commission's decisions on similar petitions for cluster 13.³
