Reference: Market Efficiency Enhancement Agreement

On August 23, 2021, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) filed revisions to the Market Efficiency Enhancement Agreement (Agreement) between CAISO and Western Area Power Administration – Sierra Nevada Region (Western).<sup>1</sup> The Agreement has been revised: (1) to allow for its extension through multiple two year terms up to a maximum six year term commencing November 1, 2021, as reflected in section 3.1; (2) to change the settlement statement timeframes in section 5.1.2 to align with CAISO's tariff and business practice manual; and (3) to update the time-of-use periods set forth in Schedule 2. The Agreement is accepted, effective November 1, 2021, as requested.

The filing was noticed on August 23, 2021, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before September 13, 2021. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.
