### MOTION OF THE CALIFORNIA INDEPENDENT SYSTEM OPERATOR CORPORATION TO WITHDRAW COMPLIANCE FILING

#### I. Introduction

Pursuant to Rule 212 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure and the rules for filing rate schedules and tariffs under the Federal Power Act<sup>1</sup>, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (the ISO) submits this motion to withdraw its filing submitted on October 12, 2010 in compliance with Commission's September 10, 2010 order conditionally accepting tariff revisions in Docket ER10-1755. <sup>2</sup> This compliance filing was inadvertently docketed in ER10-1756-001. Concurrently with this motion, the ISO is resubmitting its compliance filing in Commission Docket ER-10-1755.

## II. Good cause exists to allow the ISO to withdraw its compliance filing from Docket ER10-1756-001

On October 21, 2010, the ISO received notice that its October 12, 2010 compliance submitted in ER10-1755 was inadvertently docketed in ER10-1756-001 under the Commission's electronic tariff filing system. The ISO believes

good cause exists to allow the ISO to withdraw this compliance filing from Docket ER10-1756-001. First, allowing the ISO to withdraw its compliance filing will help ensure accurate records are kept in the Commission's databases. Second, allowing the ISO to withdraw its compliance filing will help avoid any confusion among persons who have an interest in reviewing and responding to the ISO's October 12, 2010 compliance filing. Once the ISO re-submits its compliance filing in Commission Docket ER10-1755, interested persons will receive appropriate notice and an opportunity to comment on the ISO's compliance filing. For these reasons, the ISO believes good cause exists to authorize the ISO to withdraw its October 12, 2010 compliance filing from Docket ER10-1756-001.

#### III. Conclusion

The Commission should allow the ISO to withdraw its October 12, 2010 compliance filing from ER10-1756-001. The ISO is re-submitting its compliance filing in the appropriate docket (ER10-1755). Granting this motion will ensure more accurate records and avoid unnecessary confusion among persons who have an interest in reviewing and responding to the ISO's compliance filing in ER10-1755.
