

October 24 2017 Exceptional Dispatch CPM Designation Report

Designation Summary:

The California ISO issued an Exceptional Dispatch Capacity Procurement Mechanism (CPM) designation to MNDALY 7 UNIT 3 for a system reliability need. The designation is effective October 24, 2017 for a duration of 30 days.

Duration and Cost:

Reason for CPM:

The ISO issued an Exceptional Dispatch to MNDALY_7_UNIT 3, a non RA resource, due to a heat wave in Southern California on October 24, 2017. The actual demand exceeded the day ahead forecast by more than 1700 MW and the peak demand was nearly 39500 MW which was in excess of the available RA capacity for October. To ensure sufficient supply and maintain reliability based on system conditions, the ISO issued the Exceptional Dispatch. The quantity of the CPM designation for the MNDALY_7_UNIT 3 reflects the amount of non-RA capacity of the unit that the ISO considered.
