### ISO to resume rerun production activities - Wednesday, October 27, 2004

**Subject:** ISO to resume rerun production activities - Wednesday, October 27, 2004

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**Summary:** The ISO will begin the FERC refund portion of the rerun on Wednesday, October 27, 2004. Billing inquiries based on these reruns must be sent to the ISO at, <<mailto:FERCRerunInquiries@caiso.com>>

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**Main Text:** On Friday, October 22, 2004, the ISO sent a Market Notice announcing a Conference call on the Rerun activity and indicated that rerun activity will resume on Wednesday, October 27, 2004. This portion of the rerun will apply the Mitigated Market Clearing Prices (MMCP) to Ancillary Services and Real-time Imbalance Energy.

On Thursday October 21, 2004, Scheduling Coordinators received FERC rerun data detail files in CD format (CD contains trade dates October 2, 2000 through June 20, 2001 and June 30, 2001). This CD will help Scheduling Coordinators to validate the FERC refund rerun results.

In addition, the ISO has posted a proposed FERC refund rerun calendar on the CAISO website. This calendar will provide Scheduling Coordinators with the rerun trade dates to be posted to the Settlements statements. Billing Inquiries on the Rerun Settlement Charges will be handled by e-mail rather than through the ISO Settlement Dispute System (SDS). Scheduling Coordinators must submit Billing Inquiries to FERCRerunInquiries@caiso.com no later than ten (10) business days after publication of the FERC refund statement for June 20, 2001. As currently scheduled, the deadline to submit Billing Inquiries for the entire FERC refund period is on or before January 26, 2005. Billing Inquiries should contain the same level of detail provided through the settlement dispute process, i.e. detailed explanation of the issue and specific examples illustrating the problem. One Billing Inquiry can be submitted for the entire date range impacted by the issue, rather than separate Inquiries for each trade date.
