#### FIRST QUARTERLY REPORT ON SEAMS ISSUES

In compliance with the Commission's September 21, 2006, order directing "the CAISO and neighboring control areas to meet as needed to resolve seams between them" and to "jointly report on the progress of these efforts in quarterly status reports filed with the Commission within 30 days of the end of each calendar quarter," the California Independent System Operator Corp. ("CAISO") hereby submits the first quarterly report.

Because the September 21 MRTU Order was released so close to the end of the third quarter of 2006, it allowed little time within that quarter for the CAISO and the neighboring control areas to conduct any activities toward identifying and resolving seams issues. The CAISO had, however, already participated in two meetings with external parties in the west specifically aimed at clarifying the changes the CAISO is implementing under MRTU and providing an opportunity to raise and discuss seams issues. The present report is therefore limited to discussion of: (1) the two meetings that have already occurred, and (2) activities planned or anticipated for the fourth quarter of 2006.

Due to the limited time available to obtain input on this report and the lack of time to agree upon an established process to finalize a joint report, the CAISO concluded that it was preferable to submit the initial quarterly report on a unilateral basis. In preparing this report, the CAISO did circulate a preliminary draft to the organizers of the two meetings mentioned above for their comments. The CAISO received suggested changes, several of which were accepted and are reflected in this report. The CAISO is committed to working with its neighboring control areas during the fourth quarter to develop a process for preparing joint reports as directed by the Commission starting with the January 30, 2007 report on fourth quarter activities.

#### Third Quarter Meetings with External Parties in the West

During the third quarter CAISO staff participated in two meetings with external control areas to provide an overview of MRTU and an opportunity to discuss seams issues.

The first of these meetings was the regular monthly meeting of the WestConnect Steering Committee in San Diego, which was expanded to include a special three-hour session on MRTU. The CAISO was invited to make a presentation at this meeting to educate the parties on various aspects of MRTU, including why a comprehensive redesign of the CAISO markets is needed, the rationale for the specific design proposed under MRTU, and some of the details of those elements of MRTU that were of greatest interest to the participating parties. The parties who attended this meeting generally agreed that it was a good first step, however, they all noted that an in-depth and ongoing process to identify and resolve seams issues was necessary. They further

noted the need to include knowledgeable participants from CAISO and their own operations staff in future discussions on details of seams problems and how to ensure reliability in the Western Interconnection. A complete attendance list for this meeting is provided as Attachment A to this report.

The second meeting was the regular quarterly meeting of the Seams Issues Subcommittee ("SIS") of the WECC Market Interface Committee ("MIC") in Salt Lake City. At this meeting, the CAISO did not make a formal presentation. The main objective of this meeting as regards seams with the CAISO was to plan for a special session on MRTU at the upcoming MIC meeting on October 26. As a result, the CAISO agreed to prepare a presentation for the October 26 MIC meeting similar to the one made at the August 24 WestConnect meeting, and in addition to focus on certain aspects of MRTU of particular interest to parties who engage in import and export transactions with the CAISO. A complete attendance list for the September 14 WECC Seams Issues Subcommittee meeting is provided as Attachment B to this report.

#### **Anticipated Fourth Quarter Activities with External Parties**

The following activities are currently scheduled or in process of being scheduled during the fourth quarter of 2006.

- CAISO presentation and open discussion on MRTU at the WECC Market Interface Committee, which occurred on October 26, Salt Lake City.
- FERC Technical Conference on Seams Issues, December 14-15, Phoenix.
- Individual meetings between CAISO staff and individual neighboring control areas, to identify and mitigate both operations-related and market-related seams problems.
- Development of process by CAISO and neighboring control areas for preparing joint quarterly reports in compliance with MRTU Order P 490.

The CAISO looks forward to working with all interested parties at the December 14-15

Technical Conference and intends to report on fourth quarter activities in the January

30, 2007 report, which it will develop jointly with participating neighboring control areas.

Conclusion

Wherefore, for the foregoing reasons the CAISO respectfully requests that the

Commission accept this status report.
