ORDER OF CHIEF JUDGE EXTENDING TRACK II PROCEDURAL DATES

(Issued November 10, 2003)

1. On November 7, 2003, counsel for Southern California Edison Company (SCE), on behalf of the Parties participating in the California Independent System Operator Corporation Transmission Access Charge proceeding (CAISO TAC Proceeding), requested a brief extension of the date for the issuance of the initial decision in these proceedings. The motion states that no party, including counsel for the Commission trial staff, opposes the request.

2. As grounds for the extension, SCE states that the case is currently in its third week of hearing and that the hearing is not expected to end until November 14 or 18, 2003. SCE further asserts that the longer than anticipated hearing will result in a very compressed briefing and initial decision schedule. Under these circumstances, the Chief Judge finds good cause for granting a brief extension of the currently established Track II procedural schedule. Accordingly, the Track II procedural schedule is hereby extended as follows:
