Topic 1 – Affected Systems

PG&E supports the revised draft final proposal with qualification. Regarding the CAISO's confirmation that third party agreements are not affected by the enhancements in this topic, PG&E is not wholly comfortable with the proposed language in the last sentence of section 3.7.

PG&E suggests either removing the additional language as unnecessary or adding the following:

The CAISO Affected System's mitigation remedy is the primary remedy available to the Affected System due to any impact associated with the Interconnection Customer under the CAISO Tariff. However, an Affected System's mitigation remedies that may be available outside the CAISO Tariff are unaffected by this provision.

Topic 2 – Time-In-Queue Limitations

PG&E greatly appreciates the CAISO's elucidations in response to PG&E's scenarios. PG&E supports the revised draft final proposal.
