## Market Settlement User Group – 2/20 Release Updates

- Additional Configuration Output File Deployment: 3/27
  - Required to support effective date and deployment date changes to Q1 Spring Settlements release
    - Changes LMC transparency automation effective date to 5/1/19
    - Additional change to MSS LF resources to resolve dispute
  - Pre-prod config output file: 3/14
- Q1 2019 Spring Configuration release
  - Production path deployment revised to 4/24 to move release off EIM implementation
  - Release components and configuration output file publication plan was sent 2/13
    - 1st draft config file: 3/28
    - Pre-prod config file: 4/17
  - Finalized Scope:
    - CPM settlement enhancement: new type designations to support automation
    - Remove duplicate BD in RAAIM 8831
    - Spin Non-Spin No Pay enhancement: to address fast start units

## PRR/BPM status:

- Below PRR has been created, please refer to the related market notice for the comment period:
  - **PRR1144** Update the pre-calculation MSS Deviation Penalty Quantity configuration to properly address negative SUPP quantities for cases where Day Ahead Award is zero for MSS LF resources (Effective Date: 10/1/2014)
  - This PRR will be discussed during the March/April, not on 2/26/19, BPM meetings
  - The 10-day comment period for this will be opened at the time the market notice is sent.
- 1st Comment Period: expired on 2/12/19
  - PRR1130 Update the pre-calculation Spin Non-Spin No Pay Quantity configuration to properly address fast start units (Effective Date: 5/1/2019, changed from 4/1/2019)
  - PRR1131 Documentation only change for BPM CC 6706 to show variable name associated in actual configuration (Effective Date: 1/1/2019)
  - PRR1132 Updates to BPM Configuration guides for the settlement and allocation of Capacity Procurement Mechanism (CPM) to address the automation of annual CPM (Effective Date: 5/1/2019, changed from 1/1/2020)
- Next BPM meeting for Settlements will be held on 2/26/19, will cover PRRs 1130 to 1132
