
**REQUEST OF THE

FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**


Pursuant to Rule 212 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, 18 C.F.R. § 385.212 (2003), the California Independent System Operator Corporation (“ISO”) submits this motion for an extension of time in which to file an appendix (“Appendix I”) relating to one of the issues discussed in the compliance filing being submitted by the ISO today in this proceeding (“Amendment No. 51 Compliance Filing”). The Amendment No. 51 Compliance Filing is due today. The ISO requests that it be permitted to submit Appendix I by July 9, 2003, i.e., three business days from today.

This extension is warranted because Appendix I will provide further detailed information concerning one of the preparatory rerun issues discussed in Attachment A to the Amendment No. 51 Compliance Filing, namely Issue No. 13 (Rescission of Unavailable Ancillary Service). The ISO is unable to submit Appendix I today due to the unavailability of certain ISO personnel needed to finalize the additional information provided in Appendix I.

For the foregoing reasons, the ISO requests that the Commission permit
Appendix I to be submitted by July 9, 2003.


