Salt River Project (SRP) appreciates the opportunity to provide the following comments on the CAISO's tariff clarifications.

SRP requests that the CAISO clearly differentiate changes that apply to the Real Time and Day Ahead commitments versus EIM. In EIM, units with a startup time (not total cycle time) of less than 270 min can be committed in the STUC. The tariff language does not indicate that this change has no impact to the EIM commitments.

SRP requests that the CAISO clarify if the minimum up time (MUT) used for the cycle time is applied at the configuration level or at the plant level for multi-stage units.
