On July 30, 2010, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) submitted an informational filing that provides notice regarding the revised Transmission Access Charges (TAC) effective July 1, 2009, August 1, 2009, September 1, 2009, October 1, 2009, January 1, 2010, March 1, 2010, and June 1, 2010. The CAISO states that the basis for the revision is to implement revised Transmission Revenue Requirements (TRRs) as reflected in various proceedings for: (1) the Cities of Riverside, Vernon, and Pasadena, California, (2) Southern California Edison Company (SoCal Edison), and (3) Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PGE), as well as to implement the annual revision to the ISO's TAC transition charge, and to implement the annual transmission revenue balancing account (TRBA) adjustments of all the ISO's participating transmission owners. We acknowledge the receipt of the CAISO's instant informational filing.

This informational filing was noticed on August 2, 2010, with comments, protests or motions to intervene due on or before August 20, 2010. No protests or comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

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This action is taken pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
