**COMMENTS OF THE CITIES OF ANAHEIM, AZUSA, BANNING, COLTON,  
PASADENA, AND RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA ON DRAFT TARIFF LANGUAGE FOR  
THE 2018 TARIFF CLARIFICATION FILING PROCESS**

In response to the CAISO's request, the Cities of Anaheim, Azusa, Banning, Colton, Pasadena, and Riverside, California (collectively, the "Six Cities") submit the following comments on the draft tariff language for the 2018 Tariff Clarification Filing Process posted on April 19, 2018 and discussed in the Market Notice dated April 24, 2018:

Section 4.6.3.4  
(Not covered in CAISO's draft)

Although not covered in CAISO's draft, the CAISO should take this opportunity to clarify the Tariff by eliminating Section 4.6.3.4, since all of the language in Section 4.6.3.4 also is included in Section 4.6.3.5.

Section 8.4.1.2 (4<sup>th</sup> Paragraph)

The revision shown in the draft tariff language is not consistent with the revision indicated at page 7 of the Tariff Changes Matrix, and the revision shown in the Tariff Changes Matrix appears to be correct.

Section 30.6.2.1.2.1

In the Draft Tariff Language at page 71, the final digit of the number for the Tariff sub-section (.1) is missing, although the sub-section number appears to be complete in the February 15, 2018 on-line version of the Tariff.

Section 39.10.1

In the second line, change "Exception" to "Exceptional".

Section 39.10.2

In the second line, add "Energy" after "Dispatch".

Appendix M, Section 1.5.4

In the first line, add "and/or Regulation" after "Reserves" to be consistent with the Tariff Changes Matrix at page 77 and Appendix M, Section 2.5.3.
