RE: Statement of Claim of the Modesto Irrigation District, pursuant to ISO Tariff § 13.2.2

In accordance with Section 13.2.2 of the ISO Tariff, the Modesto Irrigation District ("MID"), submits this Statement of Claim. This Statement of Claim relates to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company's ("PG&E") October 5, 2000 Statement of Claim regarding COTP and "bubble" charges from April 1, 1998 to April 1, 1999. In PG&E's Statement, among the entities listed as "Other Potentially Interested Parties" are "Holders of transmission entitlements on the California-Oregon Transmission Project ("COTP")." MID is a holder of transmission entitlements on the COTP and thus may be considered an interested party to this proceeding. While MID's participation in this proceeding also may be initiated through an intervention pursuant to the ISO Tariff Supplemental Procedure 3, MID is using the Statement of Claim procedure in order to ensure that all of its rights respecting this dispute are preserved.

While MID is generally aware of the parameters of PG&E's dispute with the ISO, MID is not in contractual privity with the ISO with regard to this matter and presently has inadequate information upon which to establish a binding position in this proceeding. Thus, on a preliminary and non-binding basis, and subject to change, MID submits the following as its Statement of Claim:

Parties to the Dispute:	ISO, PG&E, MID
Other Potentially Interested Parties:	Western Area Power Administration, Sacramento Municipal Utility District, Holders of transmission entitlements on the COTP
Claim:	From April 1998 to April 1999, the ISO improperly billed PG&E for charges amounting to \$14,172,337.08.

Relief Sought	:	Reimbursement to PG&E of the \$14,172,337.08 in charges that the ISO lacked any tariff or contract right to impose on the Company, plus interest, and any other relief deemed just and reasonable.
