


On May 15, 2001 Southern California Edison Company ("Edison") filed a Motion to Submit Supplemental Testimony in the above-captioned docket. The subject matter of the supplemental testimony was to be the application of the Grid Management Charge ("GMC") to exports from the Mojave Generating Station. The California Independent System Operator Corporation ("ISO") did not oppose this Motion.

In its Motion, Edison noted that it would require discovery responses from the ISO in order to complete its testimony on this issue. Edison subsequently served discovery requests on the ISO; answers to these discovery requests were due on May 29, 2001.


On May 24, 2001, the Presiding Administrative Law Judge issued an order granting Edison's motion. In the order, the judge noted that the ISO's discovery responses were necessary for Edison to complete its testimony, and stated that the "ISO shall respond to Edison's data requests on this issue within the 10 business-day time period..." May 24 Order at 2.

The ISO regrets that, due to competing demands on the relevant personnel, it has not yet responded to Edison's data requests. The ISO understands that Edison today is filing a Motion for Extension of Time to File Testimony, requesting an extension of one day for each day the ISO fails to provide the data responses beyond the May 29 date. The ISO does not object to this extension.
