

## Response to FERC Order on Rate Treatment for the Lake Elsinore Advanced Pumped Storage Project

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# The CAISO must respond to the FERC's Nov. 17, 2006 order by May 1, 2007.

### Appropriate rate treatment

- Talega-Escondido/Valley-Serano 500 kV Interconnect project
- Lake Elsinore Advance Pump Storage (LEAPS)

#### Provide information

- use of the facility for meeting load and managing the grid
- reduce congestion or enhance reliability

### Hold a stakeholder process

- discuss issues and solutions
- report the outcome



### Positions provided in stakeholder comments.

- LEAPS costs should not be recovered in the TAC.
- LEAPS is not unique.
- The CAISO should not discriminate.
- The CAISO should not shift risk to ratepayers.
- The CAISO should competitively procure its resources.



# Key policy principles presented for Board approval and FERC filing May 1st.

- Market based cost recovery through merchant operation of LEAPS
- CAISO independence protected
- Discriminatory treatment for LEAPS is not appropriate
- Supported by existing market and operating processes
