# **Project Purpose**




Science Applications International Corporation (SAIC) has been contracted by the California Independent System Operator (CAISO) by way of Service Order No. 9 to CAISO Contract No. 05-00782, to assist CAISO in its effort to transition from the zonal market structure to the nodal market structure known as the Market Redesign and Technology Upgrade (MRTU). SAIC's task was to review portions of five software modules that were developed, built and tested by CAISO and representative software vendors pursuant to the MRTU Tariff, ER06-615-00, (Tariff) filed by CAISO with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) and conformed through November 15, 2007. Review of subsequent Tariff amendments or any other submissions, filed with FERC was not in the scope of Service Order No. 9.

#### MRTU Systems within SAIC purview were:

- Congestion Revenue Rights (CRR)
- Market Quality System (MQS)
- Scheduling Infrastructure and Business Rules (SIBR)
- Integrated Forward Market (IFM)
- Real Time Nodal (RTN)






## SIBR Module Status








## **MQS Module Status**









## **CRR Module Status**








## **IFM/RTN Module Status**
