ORDER SHORTENING PERIOD FOR ANSWERS TO MOTION

(Issued December 2, 2002)

1. By a motion filed on November 27, 2002, Dynegy seeks to lodge in these proceedings the Commission's November 25, 2002 Order Setting Issues for Hearing, Denying Rehearing, Clarifying Creditworthiness Issues and Accepting in Part Compliance Filings, 101 FERC ¶ 61,241 (2002) and that with regard to the August 26 JS, 100 FERC ¶63,018 (2002) and stipulated issue I.A. 3. ("What other errors, if any, did the ISO make in implementing its settlement reruns?"), I incorporate the Commission's direction, mimeo at 9, that "the CAISO. . .reallocate its pro rate disbursements for the entire month of January 2001, and disburse funds from DWR allocated for January 2001 to those that supplied power for the period January 17-31, 2001." Good cause is present to shorten the period for answers to the motion to December 5, 2002.
