## Notice of Tariff Change

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Take notice that on December 11, 1998, the California Independent System Operator Corporation (ISO) tendered for filing a proposed amendment (Amendment No. 13) to the ISO Tariff. Amendment No. 13 would modify the ISO Tariff and Protocols in several respects. The modifications fall within four categories: (A) changes to encourage compliance with the ISO Tariff, (B) a change to eliminate a problem associated with the allocation of cost responsibility for transmission capacity that is derated in the ISO's Hour-Ahead Market ("HA Market"), (C) a change to use market mechanisms to assist in resolving overgeneration conditions, and (D) changes addressing a number of miscellaneous issues that have arisen in the course of the ISO's administration of the ISO Tariff.

The ISO states that this filing has been served upon the Public Utilities Commission of California, the California Energy Commission, the California Electricity Oversight Board, and all parties with effective Scheduling Coordinator Service Agreements under the ISO Tariff.

Any person desiring to be heard to protest said filing should file a motion to intervene or protest with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, 888 First Street, N.E., Washington, D.C. 20426, in accordance with Rules 211 or 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. §§ 385.211, 385.214). All such motions or protests should be filed on or before [\_\_\_\_\_\_]. Protests filed with the Commission will be considered by it in determining the appropriate action to be taken but will not serve to make the protestants parties to the proceeding.
