Dear Mr. Anders:

On May 24, 2011, the California Independent System Operator (CAISO) filed an Amended and Restated Utility Distribution Company Operating Agreement (Amended UDCOA) between CAISO and the City of Banning, California (Banning). CAISO states the Amended UDCOA updates the current UDCOA to be consistent with changes to CAISO's currently effective *pro forma* UDCOA. In addition, the parties have updated the information in the schedules to reflect the current practices of Banning and the inclusion other pertinent information. The Amended UDCOA is accepted for filing to become effective July 24, 2011, sixty days after filing, as requested.

This filing was noticed on May 25, 2011 with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before June 14, 2011. No protests or comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification or any rule, regulation or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your tariff; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against the California Independent System Operator Corporation.

This action is taken pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
