Overview

- Bylaws incorporate the Code of Conduct
- Bylaws require an annual certification of compliance by:
 - Employees
 - Substantially full time contractors
 - Board of Governors
- Tariff requires an annual "audit"
- PricewaterhouseCoopers (PwC) reported on compliance with annual certification process as described in bylaws.



Code of Conduct – Scope/Reporting

- Scope: Obtained listing of each constituent group
 - For employees compared listing to payroll register
 - Compared listing to signed certification for all groups
 - Reviewed signatures and identified exceptions (if any)
- Reporting : In accordance with American Institute of CPA standards relating to agreed-upon procedures
 - Management and the ISO Board accept responsibility for adequacy of scope of procedures

Results of Review

- PwC compared listing of all members of following classes to signed certifications as of December 1, 2006
 - Board of Governors
 - Employees
 - "Full time" contractors

No exceptions were noted
