BPM Change Management Process Timeline for Proposed Revision Request 854 on the Reliability Requirements BPM

Date	Action
July 30, 2015	California ISO submitted PRR 854 on the Reliability Requirements BPM under the title of Local capacity counting clarification for reliability demand response resource and proxy demand response resources.
July 30 – Aug 13, 2015	Initial comment period open.
August 13, 2015	Comments received from Calpine, CLECA, Joint DR Parties, PG&E, SDG&E, and WPTF.
August 25, 2015	Initial BPM change management stakeholder meeting.
September 1, 2015	ISO response to comments posted.
September 1, 2015	ISO posted recommendation.
September 1-16, 2015	Recommendation comment period open.
September 3-16, 2015	Recommendation comments received from Joint DR Parties, PG&E SCE, and SDG&E.
September 22, 2015	Recommendation BPM change management stakeholder meeting.
October 28, 2015	Due to the large number of comments and ISO edits, ISO posted an amended redlined version of the BPM, and recommendation comment period was reopened.
November 12, 2015	ISO posted another amended redlined version of the BPM within PRR 854.
November 11-13, 2015	Comments received from Calpine, CLECA, Joint DR Parties, PG&E, SCE, and SDG&E.
November 17, 2015	2 nd Recommendation BPM change management stakeholder meeting.
November 23, 2015	ISO posted responses to comments.
November 24, 2015	ISO final decision posted and appeal period opened.
December 18, 2015	Appeals submitted by CLECA, CPUC, Joint DR Parties, PG&E, SDG&E, and Six Cities.
March 16, 2016	ISO posted response to appeals.
March 30, 2016	Reply briefs submitted by CLECA, CPUC, Joint DR Parties, PG&E, SDG&E, and Six Cities.
April 22, 2016	Appeals Committee meeting.
May 13, 2016	ISO will post written decision of Executive Appeals Committee.
May 20, 2016	If appeal is approved, ISO implements Committee decision.
Next regularly scheduled Board meeting	If appeal is denied, appellants may bring issue to the Board.
